- Remote participants can be heard and shown
- Extendable to show experiments or to use the blackboard

Hybrid Seminars in any room



- Easy, mobile Setup (~700€, 2kg, fits in any backpack)
- Tracking camera and wireless microphone for freedom of movement for the teacher
- second wireless microphones, allow everyone to participate in the discussion
- Flexible use: lecture phases, discussion and group work

Translation tools will be integrated everywhere soon. E.g., automatic translation of slides is already available in MS-Teams

Online Examination is now legal ...

- ... and can be used beyond covid-19 to include remote students
- Federal state law changed in early 2021 and will stay
 - Strict rules to enforce high standards for data privacy
 - But allowance of video supervision
- Can be done with the LMS and Zoom and a smartphone
